

RETURNING TO DANCE @ Central City Dance Center



Safety is our #1 priority for SUMMER classes!

Outside classes, increased cleaning procedures, temperature checks, socially distancing, traffic flow, limited class sizes and plenty of hand sanitizer will be practiced and utilized! But most of all...students will enjoy moving and socializing while having fun with CCD staff!

Before Arriving

- Have you experienced a fever, cough, sore throat, diarrhea and/or had difficulty breathing in the past 14 days?
- When you took your temperature within the past two hours, was your temperature 100.4F or greater?
- Have you traveled by airplane internationally or domestically within the past 14 days?
- Have you traveled outside of your state within the past 14 days (other than to and from work)?
- Have you been in close contact (within 6 feet for 15 minutes at a time) with a person who has been a confirmed or waiting on COVID-19 test results?
- Have you been quarantined in the past 14 days?

Parents and Students answering **YES** to **ANY** of the above questions will not be permitted to enter the dance areas for a minimum of 14 days.

Guidelines for Summer Dance & Fitness Classes

Note: The safety and well-being of Central City Staff and Students is of utmost importance. Guidelines and procedures will be followed and are not negotiable. Guidelines are subject to revision at any time.

- ✓ Class sizes are limited to state regulations and mandates.
- ✓ Parents must sign a waiver upon their initial visit to the studio. (waiver will be e-mailed to all families registered for the 4-week Summer Dance Jam).
- ✓ Summer Dance & Fitness Classes will be conducted outdoors in the CCD parking lot under large event canopy tents with vinyl flooring.
- ✓ Check-in at the tent near the main entrance.
- ✓ Staff, Parents and Students will have their temperature taken upon arriving for dance class.
- ✓ Arrive to Central City Dance Center dressed for dance class. Changing areas will not be available.
- ✓ Common areas of the studio including the Lobby, Student Hang-Out and The City Snack Barre, will be closed.
- ✓ Restrooms will be available.
- ✓ Masks are not required to be worn outdoors but are optional. Social distancing will be followed.
- ✓ All dance areas will be labeled and spaced at least six feet apart.
- ✓ Teachers will be present to ensure social distancing is being maintained by students while attending class.
- ✓ The water fountain is closed. Please bring a water bottle labeled with your child's name. Water & snacks will be available for purchase at the tent near the main entrance.



Drop-Off and Pick-Up

- ✓ Parents are *encouraged* to drop off their children. For younger students 8 & under we encourage you to wait in your car in the case they need assistance.
- ✓ Please maintain social distancing while picking your child up from their dance space.
- ✓ After class is finished, we kindly ask that you exit the parking lot quickly to allow parents in the following classes to park. (parking will be limited to allow space for the dance tents)



During Class

- ✓ Please do not congregate around the tents during class. We need your child's full attention on the teachers. Please drop off or wait in your vehicle.
- ✓ Masks are not required when gathering outdoors, however, masks may be worn at parent's discretion.
- ✓ Students should only bring the shoes required for that day. All belongings will be stored outside along the exterior of the dance space.
- ✓ Store Kleenex, antibacterial wipes, and sanitizer in your child's dance bag to be used as needed.
- ✓ All dance areas will be labeled and spaced at least six feet apart.

Reminders

- ✓ Avoid physical contact, including hugs, high fives, and fist bumps.
- ✓ If a parent or student is ill, or living with anyone that is ill, please remain home.
- ✓ If a parent or student have underlying health conditions, please take extra precautions recommended by a physician.
- ✓ Maintain a distance of at least 6 feet from others.
- ✓ The water fountain has been disabled. Please bring a water bottle to class.
- ✓ Staff will sanitize all equipment after each class.
- ✓ Hand sanitizer is readily available.
- ✓ The Central City Dance Staff is educated on the requirements and guidelines determined by the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and MI Governor's executive orders for region 1. Region 1 includes the following counties: *Monroe, Washtenaw, Livingston, Genesee, Lapeer, Saint Clair, Oakland, Macomb and Wayne*. Central City Dance will adhere to all recommended guidelines.
- ✓ Class sizes are limited to state regulations and mandates.



If a Staff or Student reports being sick with COVID19?:

All students who were in the class and all employees who came into contact with the person will be notified. If someone says they are positive or suspected for COVID, Central City Dance Center will appropriately disinfect the facility top to bottom, then reopen following the sanitation process according to the CDC guidelines.
