Dress Rehearsal Information

- All Dress Rehearsals will be held at Saline High School.
- Please arrive 20 minutes before your dancer's scheduled time, so we can keep the rehearsal running smoothly. We may be running early.
- Students must be in full costume, hair, make-up, etc..
- **Only one adult is allowed to accompany their child to dress rehearsal.**

Ticket Information

- All seats are reserved seating.
- Tickets may be purchased by logging on to: www.centralcitydance.com & select BUY RECITAL TICKETS.
- Tickets are \$16, \$14 & \$12 each with a \$1.50 service charge.
- Please take your time when purchasing your tickets to ensure you are purchasing for the correct show.

- If you wish to have your dancer sit with you in the theater, a ticket **must** be purchased.
- All Tickets must be printed from home and brought with you to the theater.



A limited number of handicap seating is available. When choosing tickets online, select the handicap ticket option. Handicap tickets are \$16. and are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.

ShowTime Information



Arrival and Drop-off/Pick-up Info

- All dancers must arrive no later than 15 minutes before show-time with hair done and makeup applied.
- All dancers will remain backstage for the duration of the show and will be picked-up after the finale unless a ticket was purchased for them to sit in the theater.
- Any parent with a dancer under the age of 12 will need to pick-up a **backstage pass** when dropping off their child. You must present your backstage pass to security when entering the backstage area for costume changes or when picking up your child after finale. Any dancer over the age of 12 will meet their parents in the lobby of the Theater.

Backstage

- There will be several backstage volunteers to assist with the show and to supervise the dancers. **These volunteers will NOT be responsible for changing your child into their costume.** If your child needs assistance changing into/out of their costume you must obtain a backstage pass when dropping them off in the holding room.
- A TV monitor will be provided for students and volunteers to watch the show live.
- We allow students age 10 + to go straight to the dressing room after their dance if they have multiple costumes to start changing and you can meet them there. All Children 9 and under will need to be picked up in the holding room after they perform to change their costume. This will prevent children from getting lost.
- All students **MUST** report into the holding room as soon as they are ready in costume. If they are not in the holding room they will not make it to the stage. (Parents: please remind your kids that they need to stay in the holding room. They cannot hang-out in the dressing rooms, the show will not stop for a missing dancer)
- Please send your child with an activity book, puzzles or cards to keep them occupied during the show.

Costumes

- Be sure that you have the proper tights, and shoes labeled with your name to prevent confusion in the dressing rooms. We suggest each student have a garment bag labeled with their name to store and protect their costume. Downstage Dancewear sells garment bags.
- Many students bring a laundry basket labeled with their name to store all their accessories, shoes, make-up cases and belongings.
- Students should wear a cover-up to protect their costume from make-up stains before and after the performance.
- Please do not wear any jewelry or nail polish unless requested by your teacher.

Stage Make-Up & Hair

- Stage make-up is very important. It prevents the performer's face from washing out under the bright stage lights. Stage make-up is usually applied much heavier than normal day-to-day make-up. Please be sure to blend the make-up.
- Below is a list of preferred make-up colors that look great on-stage.



Eye Color- Soft blue eye shadow, eye liner and lots of mascara.

Cheek Color- Pink or rose color.

Lip Color- Pink or Red lipstick.

- *Tips on making a bun:* Use a hair net around the bun. Hairspray and lots bobby pins. Hairnets can be purchased at Downstage Dancewear.

Photos & Video Recording

- Flash photography is strictly prohibited during the performances.
- A videographer will be videotaping all of our Recital Performances.
- If you wish to purchase a DVD of your child's performance, please find the DVD pre-order forms located in the studio lobby.
- Video recording of any kind during the performances is strictly prohibited.
- Persons caught videotaping will be asked to leave. Thank you for your cooperation.
