

RETURNING TO DANCE @ Central City Dance Center



Safety is our #1 priority for 2021 Fall classes!

Increased cleaning procedures, temperature checks, socially distancing, traffic flow, limited class sizes and plenty of hand sanitizer will be practiced and utilized! But most of all...students will enjoy moving and socializing while having fun with CCD staff!

Before Arriving

- Have you experienced a fever, cough, sore throat, diarrhea and/or had difficulty breathing in the past 14 days?
- When you took your temperature within the past two hours, was your temperature 100.4F or greater?
- Have you traveled by airplane internationally or domestically within the past 14 days?
- Have you traveled outside of your state within the past 14 days (other than to and from work)?
- Have you been in close contact (within 6 feet for 15 minutes at a time) with a person who has been a confirmed or waiting on COVID-19 test results?
- Have you been quarantined in the past 14 days?

Parents and Students answering **YES** to **ANY** of the above questions will not be permitted to enter the facility for a minimum of 14 days.

Guidelines for Re-Opening

Note: The safety and well-being of Central City Staff and Students is of utmost importance. Guidelines and procedures will be followed and are not negotiable. Guidelines are subject to revision at any time.

- ✓ All class sizes will be limited this season to practice social distancing.
- ✓ All Staff, Parents and Students will stop in the vestibule for a temperature check (touchless)
- ✓ Staff and students must sanitize their hands upon entering the studio.
- ✓ Arrive to Central City Dance Center dressed for dance class. Changing areas will not be available.
- ✓ Masks are required to be worn while indoors as of July 13th, 2020. Ages 5 & under are not required to wear masks. Social distancing will be followed. Masks will not be provided
- ✓ As of July 31st, all common areas are closed until further notice. This includes Lobby, Student Hang Out and City Snack Barre. If your child has multiple classes, they may wait the studio if they are practicing social distancing.
- ✓ Avoid physical contact, including hugs, high fives, and fist bumps.
- ✓ If a staff member, parent, or student is ill, or living with anyone that is ill, please remain home.
- ✓ If a parent or student have underlying health conditions, please take extra precautions recommended by a physician.
- ✓ Maintain a distance of at least 6 feet from others.
- ✓ All surfaces will be sanitized between classes.
- ✓ FOOD IS NOT ALLOWED in the building.
- ✓ The water fountain is closed. Please bring a water bottle labeled with your child's name. Water will be available for purchase at the front desk.
- ✓ At this time, all Parent Watch Weeks are suspended.



Drop-Off and Pick-Up

- ✓ Students arriving early should wait in their car as congregating in the lobby is not permitted.
- ✓ Parents of young children will bring their child in through the front door at the main entrance. Parents will exit through the Snack Barre door.
- ✓ Parents of students ages 3-8 are encouraged to wait in their cars unless a child has severe separation or anxiety issues. If parents choose to wait for their young dancer in the lobby, please practice social distancing.
- ✓ Student's outside shoes must be removed upon entering the studio and placed inside a dance bag.
- ✓ When picking up your child, please wait outside the building. If you have young children, you may pick them up inside practicing social distancing measures. You will exit through the Snack Barre door labeled EXIT.



During Class

- ✓ Masks are required to be worn while indoors as of July 13th, 2020. The requirement to wear a face covering does not apply to individuals who:
 - a. Are younger than five years old.
 - b. Cannot medically tolerate a face covering.
 - c. Are exercising when wearing a face covering would interfere in the activity.
- ✓ Student Cubbies are not available. Students should only bring the shoes required for that day. All belongings will be taken into the dance room. Students enrolled in multiple classes will take their dance bag with them from classroom to classroom.
- ✓ Store Kleenex, antibacterial wipes, and sanitizer in your child's dance bag to be used as needed.
- ✓ Each dance room is marked with "Xs" for students to maintain 6 ft distance.
- ✓ All Ballet barres have been marked with at least 6 ft between each marker. Barres & Acro Mats will be sanitized after each use.
- ✓ Students should wash or sanitize hands every time they enter or exit the classroom.



Protecting Your Child

- ✓ The entire facility is thoroughly cleaned and sanitized daily.
- ✓ The water fountain has been disabled. Please bring a water bottle to class.
- ✓ Staff will sanitize and clean any surface utilized during class, as well as door handles and light switches, before the next class begins.
- ✓ Hand sanitizer is readily available throughout the entire studio and in all dance rooms.
- ✓ Common areas are cleaned throughout the evening.
- ✓ The CCD Staff is educated on the requirements and guidelines determined by the Center for Disease Control and MI Governor's executive orders for region 1. Central City Dance will adhere to all recommended guidelines.



If a Staff or Student reports being sick with COVID19?:

Students who were in the class and employees who encountered the ill person will be notified. If someone says they are positive or suspected for COVID, Central City Dance will appropriately disinfect the facility top to bottom, then reopen following the sanitation process according to the CDC guidelines.
